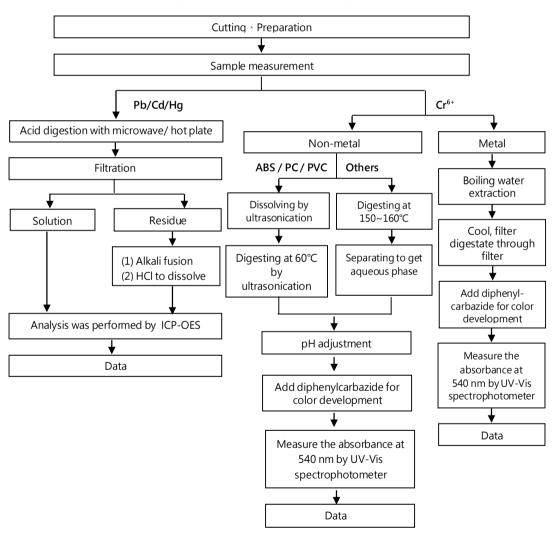
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Analytical flow chart of heavy metal

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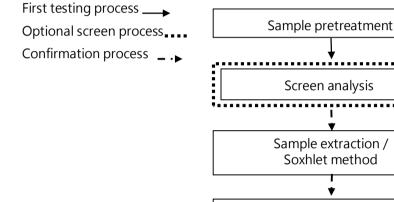


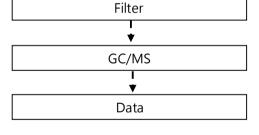

Concentrate/Dilute extracted solution

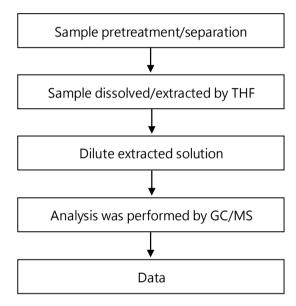


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Analytical flow chart - Phthalate

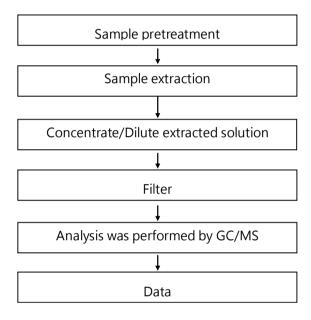

Analytical flow chart - HBCDD

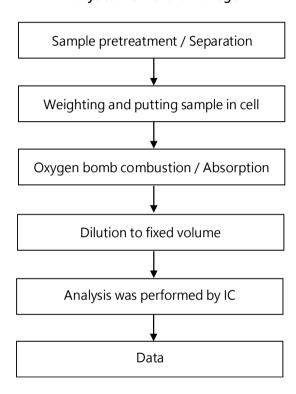




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Analytical flow chart - Halogen



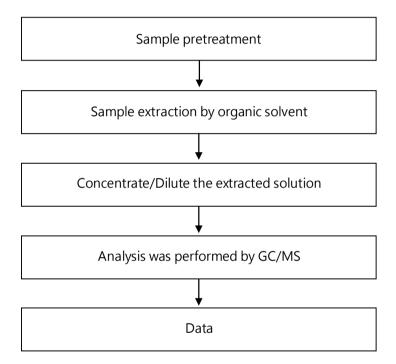

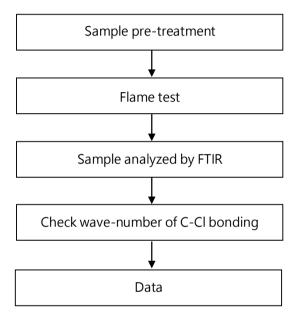

Analysis flow chart - PVC

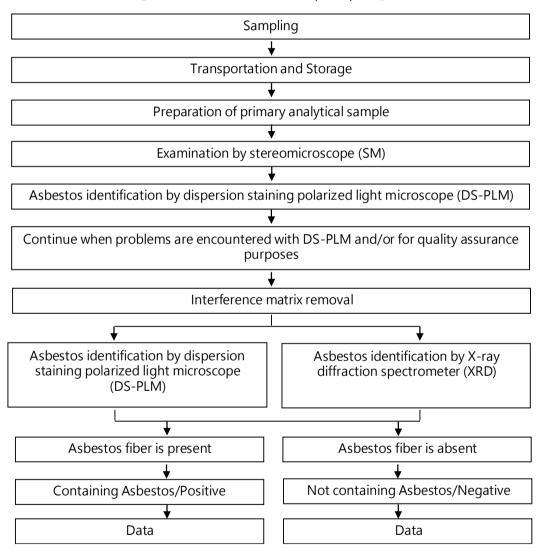

Analysis flow chart for determination of Asbestos 【Reference method: EPA 600/R-93/116】



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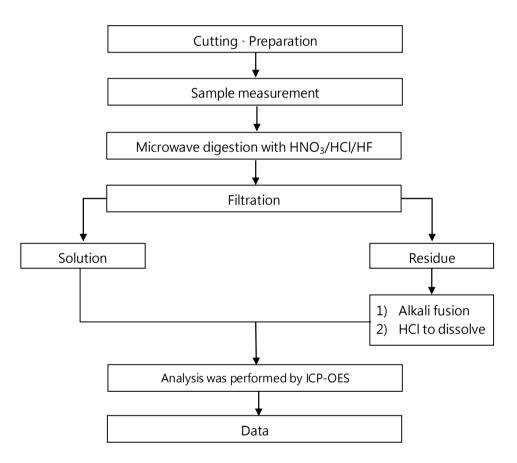

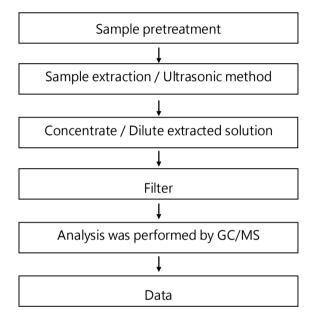

Analytical flow chart - Persistent, Bioaccumulative, Toxic (PBTs)

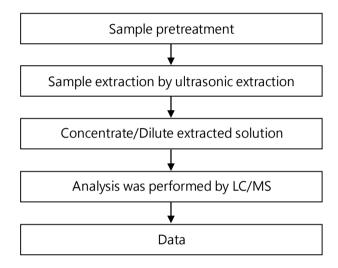

Analytical flow chart - TBBP-A

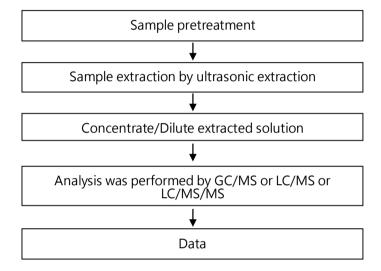
